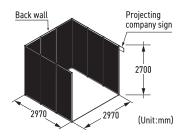

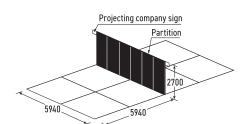

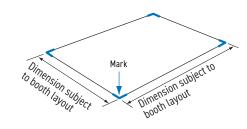
Example of 1 booth

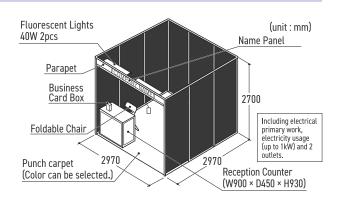
